**ADMINISTRATIVE DIRECTION NO. 2004/17**  
**IMPLEMENTING UNMIK REGULATION NO. 2000/53 ON**  
**CONSTRUCTION IN KOSOVO**

The Special Representative of the Secretary-General,

Pursuant to the authority given to him under section 2.3 of United Nations Interim Administration Mission in Kosovo (UNMIK) Regulation No. 2000/53 on Construction in Kosovo, of 25 September 2000,

Being informed that UNMIK has been requested to stop temporary construction in premises under its administrative control in Prizren pending the issuance of a construction permit by the Municipality,

Having received a communication from the Director of Administration UNMIK that UNMIK be exempted from the requirements for the application for and issuance of construction permits in regard to premises under UNMIK's administrative control,

Having considered that the temporary construction by UNMIK within premises under UNMIK's administrative control is necessary in furtherance of its mandate,

Hereby issues the following Administrative Direction:

Section 1  
Temporary Construction by UNMIK

Temporary construction by UNMIK within premises under its administrative control shall be exempt from the construction permit requirements prescribed under UNMIK Regulation No. 2000/53 on Construction in Kosovo or other relevant provisions under the law applicable in Kosovo.

Section 2  
Entry into Force

The present Administrative Direction shall enter into force on 1 July 2004.
