REGULATION NO. 2005/1

**ON THE PROMULGATION OF
THE LAW ON PRIVATE PRACTICES IN HEALTH
ADOPTED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF KOSOVO**

The Special Representative of the Secretary-General,

Pursuant to the authority given to him under United Nations Security Council resolution 1244 (1999) of 10 June 1999,

In conformity with sections 9.1.44 and 9.1.45 of the Constitutional Framework for Provisional Self-Government in Kosovo (UNMIK Regulation No. 2001/9),

Taking into account a communication from the President of the Assembly of Kosovo, dated 21 October 2004, concerning the Law No. 2004/50 on Private practice in the Health, adopted by the Assembly of Kosovo on 27 September 2004,

Hereby promulgates effective as of the date of signature the Law on Private Practice in the Health as adopted by the Assembly of Kosovo (Law No. 2004/50) attached to the present Regulation, subject to the following changes:

(a) The term “citizens” shall be replaced, throughout the Law, with the term “residents”;

(b) Article 5.1 (c) shall be revised to make reference to the Law on Rights and Responsibilities of Kosovo Residents in the Health Care System, as promulgated by UNMIK Regulation No. 2004/47 of 19 November 2004;

(c) Article 5.2 the reference to article 45 of the Kosovo Health Law, promulgated on 20 August 2004 is incorrect and should be replaced by reference to article 46 of the same Law; and

(d) The wording “Disciplinary and Penal Provisions” in the heading and first paragraph of article 28, shall be replaced with “Administrative Sanctions”.

These changes shall be reflected in the final official text of the Law.
